



Dear friends and parishioners,

As I write this in the middle of what has become known as 'lockdown three', I have been reflecting on how we can manage to keep going and keep hoping in a situation which has gone on longer than most of us imagined it might (although I am aware of some people last March who were mumbling darkly along the lines of 'this'll go on longer than we think...').

How to hope when there seems to be no ending, even acknowledging with thankfulness the work which has gone into developing and distributing a vaccine, is where we are now; those whose businesses are shaky or collapsing, those whose mental health is taking a battering; those who are working all hours and still struggling to put food on the table; and those who are simply alone; all need hope in something which seems never-ending.

Right at the beginning of February the church celebrates the Feast of Candlemas. At the centre of this story are two elderly people who refuse to give up hope. Both of them have been waiting all their lives, worshipping at the temple, in the belief that they will see the Son of God before they die – this is what they have been promised and this is what they believe. And when a poor couple from the country, Joseph and Mary, with not enough money even to make the normal sacrifice, comes to have their baby blessed, the hope and faith of Simeon and Anna are rewarded. In the child they see the love of God, made real and whole and present. No-one else in the temple at Jerusalem seems to hear or even acknowledge what they are saying and seeing.

The story has always reminded me of two things: how undervalued the ability to hope is – these two people hoped all their lives long; and also that the love of God can be right under our noses sometimes and we won't even see it, because it doesn't look like we expect it to.

May God sustain us all with the hope that we need to carry on in these times; and may we find God again where we least expect him.



ST MARY'S CHURCH

Church open in daylight hours: we are delighted that, in this third lockdown, we are still able to keep the church building open daily from approximately 9am until 4pm. This is only possible thanks to our dedicated team of volunteer unlockers and lockers. Everyone is very welcome to visit the church, to offer personal prayers (perhaps writing your own prayer and hanging it on the Prayer Tree?) and to enjoy a place to be still in the beautiful medieval, grade 1 listed, building.

We are asking all visitors to follow government and Church of England Covid 19 safety requirements, that is, to register using the NHS Test and Trace app, to sanitise their hands, to wear a face covering and to maintain a 2m social distance.

Closure of church for Sunday services: at the present time with rapidly rising Covid 19 infection rates, we are unable to hold services of public worship.

CHARITIES

Every year at Christmas, the church donates to charities suggested by members of the congregation. We try to hit a balance between local, national and global organisations that help to fight poverty, health problems and children's needs. This year we gave £100 to each of the following charities: East Anglian Air Ambulance; Keech Hospice Care; Open Doors (Supports persecuted Christians); Mercy Ships (provides medical and surgical treatment, particularly for children in developing nations); Women's Aid Luton; Dunstable Foodbank; Society of Mary and Martha (support for mental health).

Usually a large amount of money is collected for the Children's Society by carol singing around the village, the Christingle service and a carol service. None of this could take place this year. During the Christmas Eve carols and handbell afternoon a collection raised £87 for the Children's Society – this was made up to £187 by the PCC.

The church has been open to individuals daily since last summer. We are very grateful to Bola, Kim, Isobel, Jane, Martin and Pam who have daily sanitised it so that everyone can be safe.

Despite all the lockdown restrictions and having to work from home at the same time as trying to home school (talk about multi-tasking!) we do wish all residents a Happy New Year and hope that it is a minor improvement on 2020.

It has been brought to our attention that there are several thoughtless people around who insist that their cars are so precious they should be parked on the pavement or grass verge. To do so is actually an offence so please, think of all those who are trying to improve their health and their sanity by walking around our beautiful village, and keep 4 wheels on the road.

This is the last chance to prove to all that you look after your garden by cutting your hedge that borders either a footpath or highway. Nesting birds mean that if you miss February, you cannot cut it until June and by then you may not be flavour of the month – so it's up to you!!

Whatever you are doing, whether it be walking the dog, walking for health or sanity, or just staying indoors in the warm, please stay safe and follow guidelines.

A MEDICINE CHEST IN YOUR GARDEN!

Your garden, or even window box, can be fun and useful at the same time. Now is the time to start planning your garden.

A herb garden is not only a place of beauty, it's also a medicine chest, holding natural remedies to many ailments. Until the 17th Century, herbs were the principal ingredients of medicinal practice, but they've been replaced by synthetic products. Some countries, such as India and China, still widely use herbs as medicine.

- When dried, the bright orange-yellow flowers of **Californian poppies** can be made into a calming tea, which can be brewed from the flowers and used to ease insomnia.
- An antispasmodic herb, **chamomile**, is also good for nervous stomach upsets when used in moderation. Pour boiling water over the crushed leaves, infuse, strain and enjoy.
- When you're suffering wind or stomach cramps, a cup of **fennel** seed tea can ease the pain. Put one teaspoon of seed in a cup, pour over boiling water, let it stand, then strain before drinking. Chew fennel seeds after a rich meal to freshen breath and settle the stomach.
- The aniseed-flavoured leaves of **French tarragon** stimulate digestion and help the body to break down fatty foods that are high in cholesterol.
- When eaten regularly, **garlic** can lower blood fat levels, including cholesterol, and reduce the chances of getting blood clots.
- A tea made from **hyssop** leaves is an excellent tonic if you have a cough or cold, as it's a gentle decongestant and expectorant. However, *avoid it if you're pregnant*.
- Try a cup of **peppermint tea** the next time you have indigestion or feel bloated after a meal. Put a handful of fresh or dried leaves into a mug, pour over boiling water, and allow it to stand for five minutes. Put a lid over the top to stop the steam dissipating the essential oils.
- Tea made from fresh **rosemary** leaves helps stimulate the memory and clear a hangover. Drink in moderation, as too much can be harmful.
- Not only is **lavender** a tonic for the nervous system, it's also a calming sedative. Add a few drops of lavender oil or a handful of lavender flowers to a bath, or make a bath bag: wrap lavender sprigs in a piece of muslin, tie it up and hang it under a running tap.



Warning: these are remedies for mild, temporary conditions. If you continue to feel unwell, contact your GP.


