

Dear friends and parishioners,

It's a year now since I sat down to write a letter for the Parish Link of April 2020 with which I really struggled – I've looked back and my opening sentence was, "I have started this letter afresh several times this month – and begun again as every day has brought change to our daily lives and the lives of those we love".

Living with change has become normal now for many of us, as has, for some, the monotony of similarity; people who have lost so much and others who still cannot venture outside their front doors. The things which many took for granted, a meal with friends, a hug from a loved one, a football match, a visit to a theatre, museum or cinema, a steady income, even a roof over our heads, all swept away.

For the first disciples at Easter, everything on which they had come to accept and rely was also swept away. What they had thought would happen, a revolution which would sweep away the power of the Romans and the ruling elite, was crushed and literally crucified. Yet from the darkness of Good Friday (which is as much the centre of the Christian faith as Easter Day, because you can't have one without the other) love and light and new life slowly dawn.

Like those first disciples, although we sometimes cannot believe it, there is always love and light and new life. For some of us it will be a long time coming. Yet the fundamentals of Christianity speak through Jesus of everything we need at this time: good news, peace, something to trust in, someone to hold on to, security and most of all love. This is the revolution which the disciples weren't expecting. It is still the revolution which awaits our discovery; an empty tomb filled with love, not just at Easter but always.

With my love and prayers, this coming Eastertide and always,







KENSWORTH VILLAGE HALL COMMITTEE

At a virtual meeting held on 10th March the Committee confirmed the following:

- * the Hall will be open for the government elections on 6th May, with strict rules enforced by the government on how these elections are to be set up to ensure safety of electors.

- *we hope to reopen the Hall according to government guidelines on 17th May. Obviously, this date is not set in stone as we will be guided by updates on the pandemic to comply with guidelines. The rules governing the numbers of people able to use the Hall will apply. Plans will be made to complete a deep clean to make it COVID-secure and ongoing cleaning plans will be adhered to.

Date of next meeting: Tuesday, 11th May at 7.30pm via Zoom. This meeting will also be the Council's Annual General Meeting.

The meeting expressed thanks to Central Beds highways for progress made over recent months on several long-standing items and asked Cllr.
