





Resolution of the PCC of St Mary Magdalene, Whipsnade, passed by email, on 5th September 2023


Garden of Remembrance memorial plaque:

'The Parochial Church Council of Whipsnade St Mary Magdalene, having constructed a second Garden of Remembrance in Whipsnade churchyard in 2022 to provide additional space for the burial of cremated remains; and desirous of placing at the front of the new Garden a Portland stone memorial plaque identical to that in the first Garden (measuring in centimetres 91.5 x 47, 14.5 high at rear and 4.5 at front, and shown in the attached photograph A); hereby authorise the seeking of a faculty to install this plaque (to be sited in centrally at the east boundary of the Garden) (see attached photograph B and plan).'


