

"I Have One Word for You: Plastics" – you may recognise this quote from The Graduate when Dustin Hoffman is taken aside and given the key to financial success for the future, and so this material has taken over the world, sealing everything in plastic, and one more time for good measure.

I love the idea of living without purchasing any plastic, but when I look at my recycling bin and the black bin rubbish where the soft plastics pile up, I take a deep breath. How would I do this? THE BEST BARBECUE SAUCE!

This will be perfect with any meat on your barbecue, and avoids the ultraprocessed ingredients in bought sauces. It will keep in the fridge in an airtight container for 2 weeks, and frozen it will keep for 3 months.

Ingredients

Start with a base of 250ml ketchup, 1 tbsp mustard, Worcestershire sauce, and brown sugar. From there, you can add in other flavours to taste e.g. garlic, onion, chilli, cumin, paprika, and cayenne pepper. You can also add in some sweetness with 1 tsp honey or molasses. Finally, add some acidity with 2 tbsp of either cider vinegar or lemon juice.

Mix them together in a bowl. Taste as you go along and adjust as needed. You may need to add more sugar for sweetness or more vinegar for acidity, depending on your taste preferences.

Place the sauce in a pot over medium heat and bring it up to a simmer. Simmer for about 10 minutes, stirring occasionally until it thickens up slightly. Once it has reached the desired consistency, let it cool, then transfer it into an airtight container for storage in the refrigerator. Now that you have created the perfect barbecue sauce, all that's left is to enjoy it!

The CBC website (www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/waste and recycling/fly tipping/rogue rubbish collectors) provides information on rubbish disposal, including spotting rogue collectors and finding a licensed waste carrier, including an example of a genuine waste carrier license.

Neighbourhood Plan: we are in the early stages of developing a Neighbourhood Plan, which is a local planning document developed by a community to guide the future development of their area. It outlines a vision for the area and sets policies for how land is used and developed, influencing planning decisions and shaping the community. More information will be available very shortly on the Parish Council's website.

Community Governance Review: CBC will be carrying out a Community Governance Review (CGR) over the coming months, conducting a consultation and inviting submissions. A CGR is a way to make sure that, at parish level, governance arrangements are working as efficiently and effectively as they should be.
