Dear friends and parishioners,

For the first time in ages, I am looking out of my window as I write this at a clear blue sky, with a ground sparkling with frost and, most amazingly, at glorious bright sunshine! The grey and rainy days have seemed incessant this winter, and almost everyone I know has been yearning for light.

In my faith, Jesus is often described as Light, and, when, in stories from the Bible, he is trying to get the first disciples to see and understand that he is God-with-us, we read the words "I am the light of the world". And when I work with children in our local schools, we have often talked together about how it feels when you turn a light on in a room which is dark.

Light can comfort and give hope, it can also reveal and change. I believe that we are part of all of that, through what we do and who we are. So it's not just the light of God which surrounds us, but we too can be like lights shining in dark places for those around us.

It's funny how lyrics of songs that we have known for many years stick in our heads. When I was little, I sang in Sunday School and at school a children's hymn which went like this:

"Jesus bids us shine with a clear, pure light,
Like a little candle, burning in the night,
In this world of darkness, so let us shine,
You in your small corner, and I in mine".

I have never forgotten this. Even when things seem very dark, I know that the light and love of God are surrounding me, and I believe too, that in the small corners of our villages, we can be that light and love for each other – even when the day is grey and rainy.

USING AI RESPONSIBLY: CUTTING YOUR CARBON FOOTPRINT

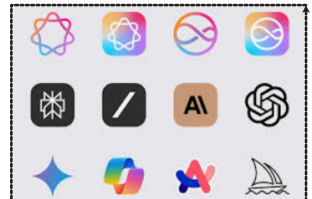

- Think before using AI for very small or simple tasks that could be done without it.

Using AI thoughtfully

- Use tools like ChatGPT with a clear purpose, rather than out of habit.
- Avoid repeated or duplicated requests that increase computing use.
- Support companies that use renewable energy for their digital services.

Speeding: the Council has been continuing with its efforts to get more effective controls in place against reckless drivers speeding through the village. We have repeatedly made the case for a new vehicle activated speed sign (VAS) but this has been stalled somewhere between CBC highways (safety) officers and the police, who are requesting yet more survey data. Meanwhile, the Parish Council is trying to establish a speed watch group to cover the central village. STIR THE DANCING DAFFODIL!

Narcissus (plural *Narcissi*, usually called a **daffodil**) is the botanic name for a genus of mainly hardy, mostly spring-flowering, bulbs in the *Amaryllidaceae* family, native to Europe, North Africa, and Asia.

It has bright *perianths* (petals) with a darker central *corona* (trumpet). The petals can be a variety of colours: bright yellow (the most common); white; pale yellow; or even peach.

During the winter, the flowering part of narcissus dies away, and the plant lives on underground in a *bulb*. A bulb is an onion-like structure, which is filled with food. The plant lives off this food during the winter, protected from the cold by the soil above.

Narcissus Pseudonarcissus, commonly named the **Wild Daffodil** or **Lent Lily**, is a perennial flowering plant which grows wild in this country, and is the variety referred to in Wordsworth's famous poem written in 1802:



I wandered lonely as a cloud
That floats on high o'er vales and hills,
When all at once I saw a crowd,
A host, of golden daffodils;
Beside the lake, beneath the trees,
Fluttering and dancing in the breeze.

Continuous as the stars that shine
And twinkle on the milky way,
They stretched in never-ending line
Along the margin of a bay:
Ten thousand saw I at a glance,
Tossing their heads in sprightly dance.

The waves beside them danced; but they
Out-did the sparkling waves in glee:
A poet could not but be gay,
In such a jocund company:
I gazed—and gazed—but little thought
What wealth the show to me had brought:

For oft, when on my couch I lie
In vacant or in pensive mood,
They flash upon that inward eye
Which is the bliss of solitude;
And then my heart with pleasure fills,
And dances with the daffodils.

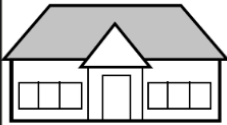

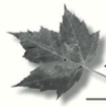

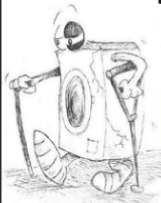
